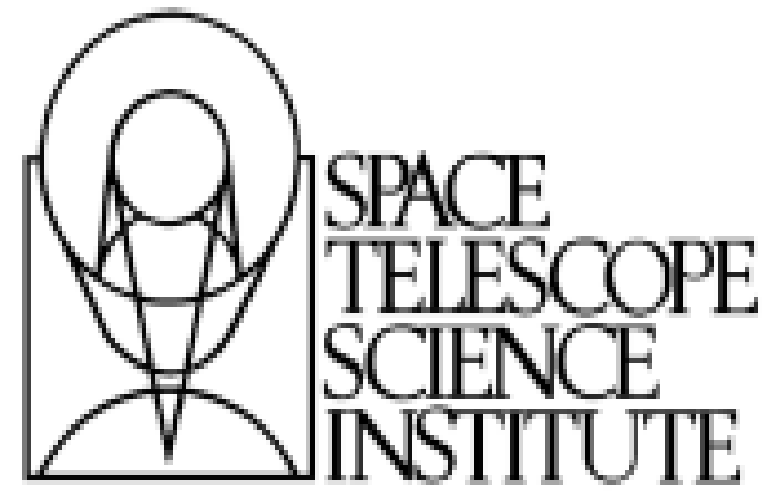
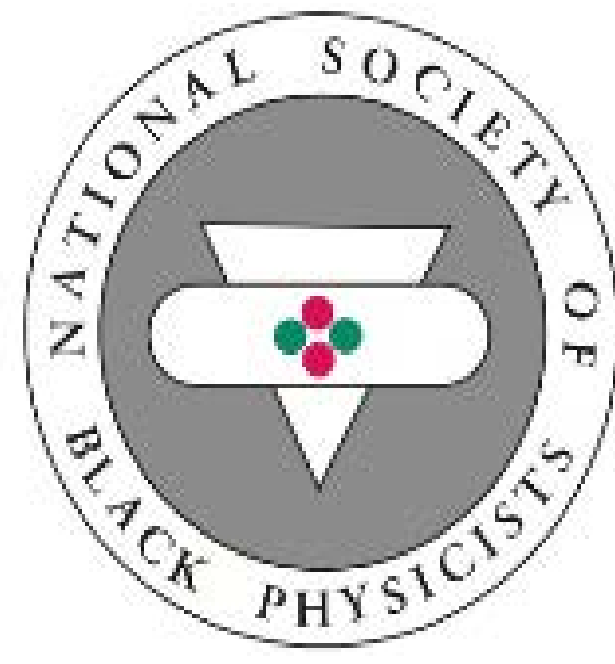
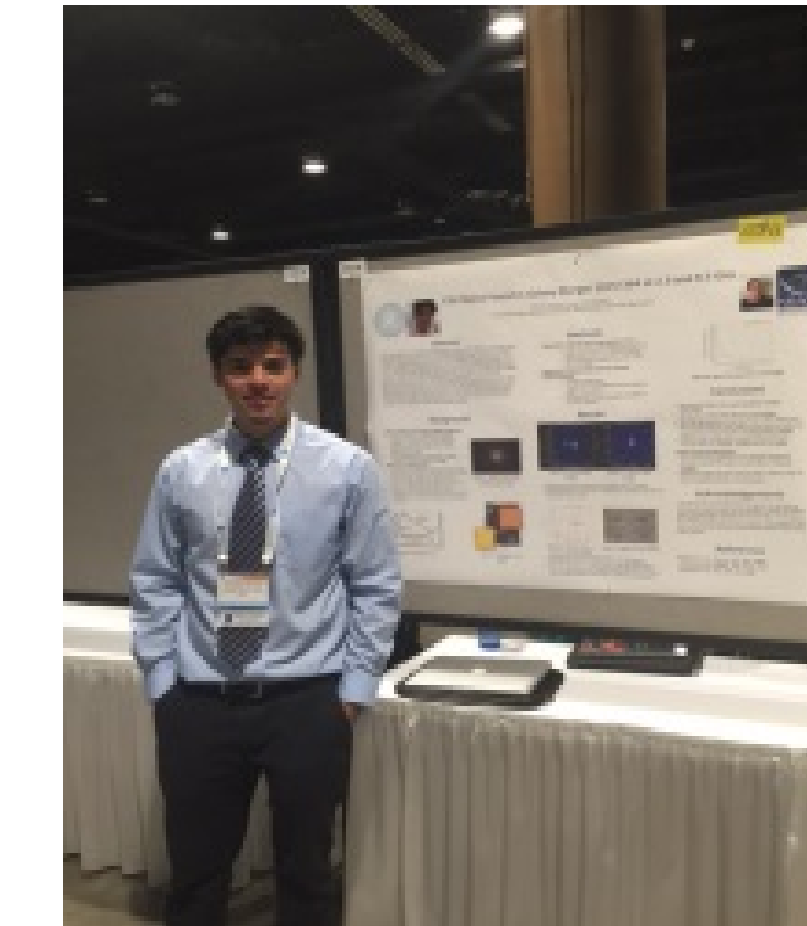

The NAC model is distinguished by an intensive mentoring model emphasizing:

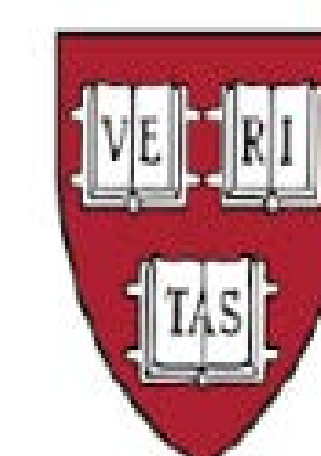
